BIG thank you to those who joined the Main Event fundraising night last week! Despite the smaller turnout, the fundraiser was a success! The group was able to raise just over \$400 that will cover sponsoring another child! To-date, we have raised \$1,482 between the Penny War, Main Event night and Mighty Shepherd Mondays. Our goal is to raise about \$3,200 which would sponsor about 8 Haitian students.


