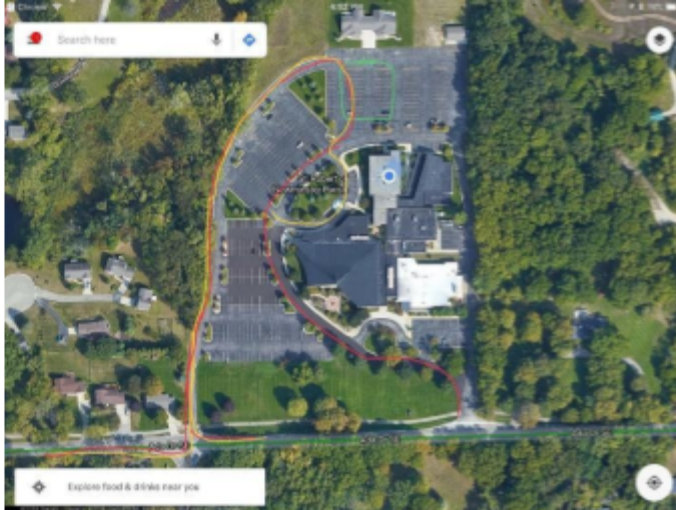

Revised Parking Lot Procedure



Drop-off: When arriving to school, use the east entrance and follow the signs to the school parking area. The red lines on the map indicate the approved route to the parking area.

The school parking lot is near door F on the north side of the church. Please note the green parking area on the map.

Kindergarten students may be dropped off at the curb near door F. Please follow the loop indicated in yellow and stop when you see Mrs. Peters for drop off. She will help unload your child and get him/her to the right classroom. Students may be dropped off at 7:45 am.

All exiting traffic must leave via the west exit from 7:00-9:00 am and 2:00-4:00pm on school days. Note the red lines on the map designating the exit pattern. Both lanes on the west exit during these hours.

Pick-up: Preschool students will be brought to the main school doors and dismissed one by one to parents who should wait at the bottom of the outside steps to pick up their child. Kindergarten can meet their child at the curb in the car
